

Major Scope of Work

Work Description

- Replace Street and Platform Stairs
- Install Two Street-to-Mezzanine Elevators
- Install Two Mezzanine-to-Platform Elevators
- Demolish and Rebuild Entire Mezzanine. Raise Underside of Mezzanine and Lower Street Surface to Prevent Future Vehicular Hits
- Reinforce Street Columns and Foundations For Additional Loads due to Elevators and New Facilities
- Replace Platform Roofs (Wooden Canopies) and Mezzanine Overpass Walkway Roofs




New Street Elevator Locations










Work Description

ADA Boarding Zone

New Platform Edges

Replace Damaged Platform Precast Planks and Repair Concrete Cast in Place Slab

Repair Damaged Steel

Replace Existing Platform Canopies Damaged during Hurricane Sandy

Replace Existing Stair Refuge Enclosure with New Glass Enclosure at all Four Platform Stairs

Replace Platform Light Posts, Signs, Gates, Railings, Benches, Sandboxes and Refuse Bins








PHASE 1 PLAN

Fall 2018— March 2019

- Protect trees
- Asbestos abatement
- Relocate two bus stops
- Remove stairs:
 S2 at Columbus Triangle
 S3 at Hoyt Playground
- Remove bus shelter
- Install micropiles for foundations
- Build foundations for elevators and stairs
- Reinforce street level steel columns and foundations
- Install drainage pipes, catchbasins and manholes




Intersection Closure

- Signage, Traffic Enforcement Agents, and Crossing Guards will be provided






Detour During All Track GOs and Complete Intersection Closure



Saturday Traffic Conditions




Detour During Complete Intersection Closure












Detour DuringComplete Intersection Closure






Detour DuringComplete Intersection Closure





Bus Routes







Train Service During the Closure

- Nine month full closure;
 March-December
- During the closure Ditmars Blvd and 30th Av provide alternate subway service
- During 13 Weekends, N/W service will not run north of Queensboro Plaza. Shuttle buses will be provided during these weekends.
- (Feb 23-24), March 16-18, March 23-24, April 6-7, April 13-14, June 15-16, and June 22-23.



Track Replacement

Improves the reliability of the track and signal equipment

Fewer delays for customers

Replaced 2,496 feet of track and ten track switches since 2017 Queensboro – 39 Av Ditmars – Astoria Blvd

ADA compliant platform gaps





Track Replacement

Winter/Spring 2019:

Replacing nearly 5,000 feet of track on the northbound track between 36 Av and 30 Av.

Track is over 35 years old

Work will overlap with station work

Requires northbound trains to run express during weekdays, skipping stations in one direction

ADA compliant platform gaps

Increase reliability and reduce delays

February 4 – April 19 (except Presidents Day, Feb 18)

Weekends: February 23-24, *March 9-10*, March 16-17, March 23-24, & *March 30-April 1*

Service Plan

Northbound N trains run express from Queensboro Plaza to Astoria Blvd (express to Ditmars Blvd after Astoria Blvd closure)

W Trains run along the Q line to 96 St

Work is weather dependent

Traffic Plan

During Track work we need to detour some traffic from 31st St

Exact detour will change as the location of the track replacement changes

Current detour until March 1: 31st Street between 31st Ave and 34th Ave

North Bound: Will run "Against the Normal Direction of Traffic", between 31st Ave & 34th Ave.

South Bound: Will be diverted at 31st Ave onto Crescent St


