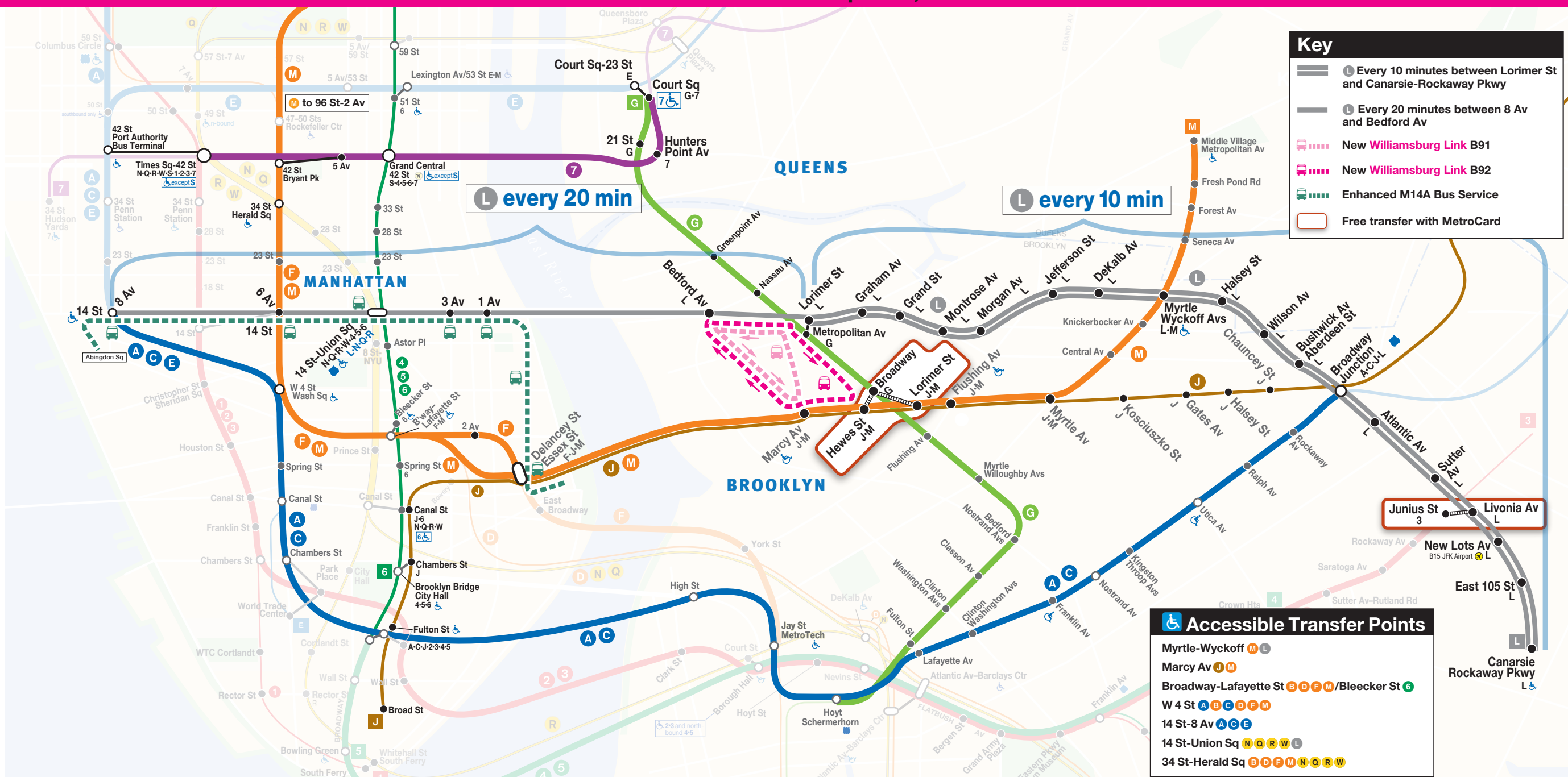

Guide to a faster, reliable trip that avoids possible crowding: alternate service and the M14A/D

L service will continue as normal during the busiest times, the main commuting times on weekdays.

On nights and weekends, L service operates around our construction area. This means trains will run less frequently than usual. To help you get around, we're giving you more options in addition to the L by enhancing other subway lines and bus routes.

- Weekdays**
5 AM to 10 PM — Regular L service reducing 8 PM
- Weeknights**
10 PM to 1:30 AM — Reduced L service
1:30 AM to 5 AM — Regular L service
- Weekends**
6 AM to 1:30 AM — Reduced L service

L nights and weekends

Plan to use alternate service to avoid crowding.

- Weeknights 10 PM to 5 AM**
- Service ramps down at 8 PM to make room for work trains.
 - Starting at 10 PM, the L runs every 20 mins between Brooklyn and Manhattan and every 10 mins between Lorimer St and Canarsie-Rockaway Pkwy.

Weekends 10 PM Fri until 5 AM Mon

- Service ramps down at 8 PM Fridays to make room for work trains.
- From 10 PM Friday through 5 AM Monday, L runs every 20 mins between Manhattan and Brooklyn. Between Lorimer St and Canarsie-Rockaway Pkwy, L runs every 10 mins from 10 PM to 1:30 AM on Friday and from 6 AM to 1:30 AM on Saturday and Sunday.

If you take the L

- If you normally take the L within Manhattan, the M14A/D may be faster. Transfer from the subway to the bus is free.
- If you miss an arriving L train, it may be faster to take another subway or the M14A/D.
- We have you covered. If you swipe into the subway and decide to take the bus instead, our team is there to assist.
- Stations will be crowded and you may have to wait in the mezzanine before we can let you onto the platform. There may also be wayfinding measures directing you to access the platform from one direction and exit from another.
- The L may be held in some stations, including 14 St-Union Sq, with the doors open for a few minutes. This is to keep it running on the every 20 minutes schedule.

Enhanced M G 7 and bus options

Because the L will run with reduced service nights and weekends, we're enhancing service on the M14A, the M G and 7 and implementing the new Williamsburg Link buses.

During the busiest hours on weekends, while the L runs every 20 mins:

- The M14A/D combined will run every 3 mins
- M every 8 mins
- J every 10 mins
- G every 8 mins
- 7 every 4 mins
- Williamsburg Link every 3 mins each route

Taking a combination of these other options may make your trip to and from 14 St-Union Sq faster.

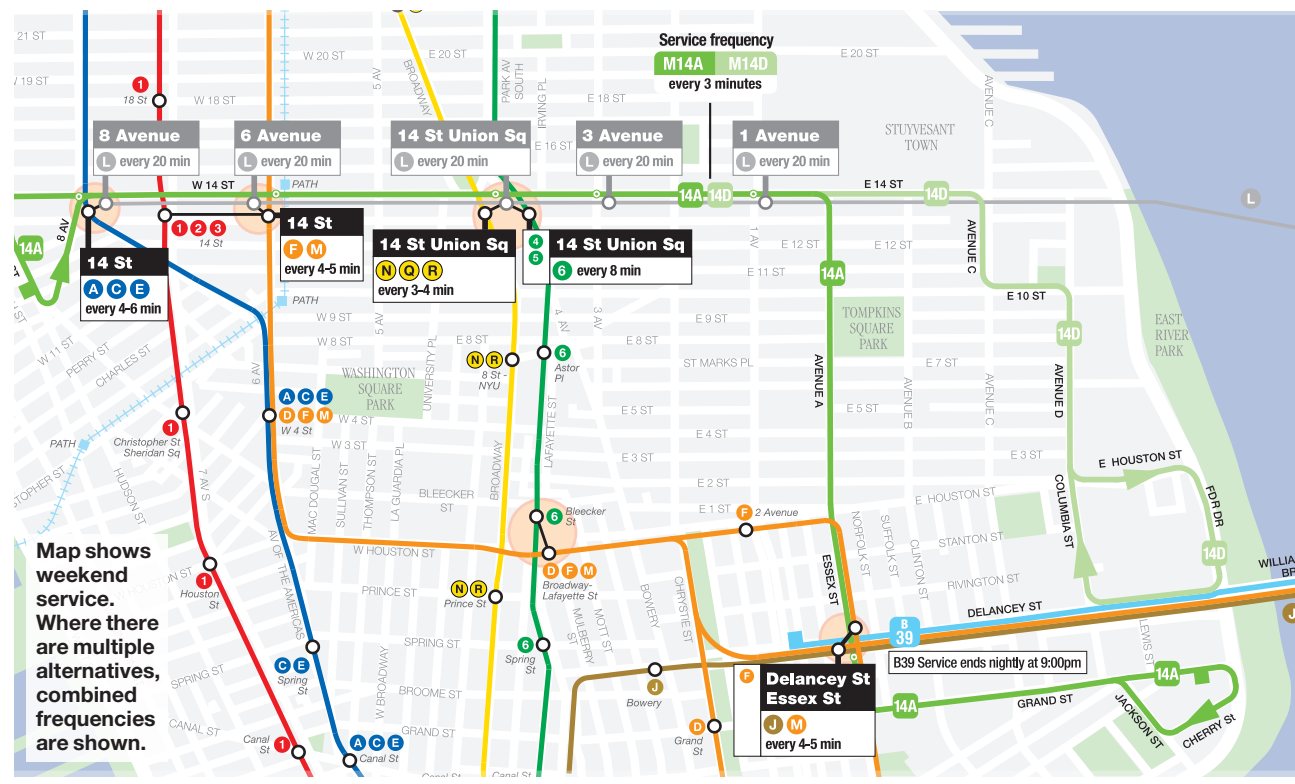
Here's what your weekend trip could look like:

Destination	L first train during low ridership times (assumes 10 mins wait)	L during busy ridership times (assumes waiting for second train)	Using alternate subway and bus (Williamsburg Link and/or M14)
Bedford Av	18.5 mins	38.5 mins	35 mins
Lorimer St	20 mins	40 mins	34 mins
Myrtle-Wyckoff	29.5 mins	49.5 mins	37 mins
Rockaway Pkwy	44 mins	64 mins	47 mins
Rockefeller Center	23 mins	43 mins	16 mins

Key things to remember as you plan the route that works best for you:

- The M14A/D bus stop is just outside the station and travels along 14th St. Follow the signs to the street and check out MYmta for arrival information.
- To get to Brooklyn, take the downtown 6 to Bleecker St/Broadway-Lafayette St and transfer there to the Brooklyn-bound M.
- For a fully accessible route, take the N Q R W to 34 St-Herald Sq and transfer there to the Brooklyn-bound M.
- If you're traveling to Williamsburg, the new Williamsburg Link B91 and B92 buses connect the J M at Marcy Av to the Bedford Av L and Metropolitan Av/Lorimer St G L stations.

Meet your new service alternatives for nights and weekends



Key bus stops:

- 8 Av**
Eastbound M14A/D - South side of 14 St east of 8th Ave
Westbound M14A/D - North side of 14th St west of 8th Ave
- 6 Av**
Eastbound M14A/D - South side of 14th St east of 6th Ave
Westbound M14A/D - North side of 14th St west of 6th Ave
- 14 St-Union Square**
Eastbound M14A/D - South side of 14 St east of 4th Ave
Westbound M14A/D - North side of 14th St east of 4th Ave
- 3 Av**
Eastbound M14A/D - South side of 14th St east of 3rd Ave
Westbound M14A/D - North side of 14th St west of 3rd Ave
- 1 Av**
Eastbound M14A/D - South side of 14th St east of 1st Ave
Westbound M14A/D - North side of 14th St east of 1st Ave
- Essex St/Delancey St**
Eastbound M14A - West side of Essex St south of Delancey St
Westbound M14A - East side of Essex St north of Delancey St
