Staten Island Railway

Staten Island Railway (SIR) operates service between the Lower New York Bay and the West Shore of Staten Island. The line runs from St. George to Tottenville, with major stations including Stapleton, Clifton, Grasmere, Old Town, Grant City, Jefferson, New Dorp, Oakwood Heights, Bay Terrace, Great Kills, Bay Terrace, Annadale, Etingville, Huguenot, Pleasant Plains, Arthur Kill, and Tottenville.

Ferries operated by the Trust for Governors Island run daily from the Battery Maritime Building to South Street. NYC ferry operates year-round service to Governors Island. Visit nycferries.com.
